

TRAVEL KENNEL



The right choice of travel kennel will ensure safety and welfare to your pet, avoiding inconveniences during the boarding. There are many brands in the market. We indicate the Vari Kennel model (manufacturer: Petmate), an international reference approved by airlines. The Vari Kennel has superior quality and presents better ventilation, comfort and safety to the animal. Our partner, the Animal Fun store, has all sizes of kennels and soft sided carriers for transport in the cargo compartment and cabin.

*****Unapproved or inferior quality kennel brands are constantly refused by airlines at the boarding time, which can lead to missed flight and extra expenses.***





KENNEL REQUIREMENTS

- The animal should be able to freely turn 360° inside the kennel;
- When the animal is seated, its head must not touch the ceiling, and there must be a gap of approximately 10 cm (between the head and the ceiling);
- The kennel needs windows or ventilation holes on its sides and bottom;
- The kennel has to be mounted with screws, not with plastic latches;
- The door must be made of metal with a 2 or 3 point locking and anti-leak latch;
- The kennel cannot have wheels;
- The material requires quality and strength;
- The model must comply with IATA (International Air Transport Association) requirements




**In cases which the airline considers the breed to be dangerous or aggressive, it may require the travel kennel to be made of industrialized wood or metal. Carga Viva Export also supplies these kennels.*



HOW TO CHOOSE YOUR PET'S RIGHT KENNEL SIZE

The kennel size depends on the species, breed, age and the pet's size.

Height: The animal must be seated. You will measure from the top of the head to



Length: The animal with all four legs on the ground should be measured from the nose tip to the tail base



**For snub nosed breeds (brachycephalics) a larger kennel is recommended. If you have followed the above guidelines, and the pet fits into the 300 numbered kennel, it is recommended that you buy the 400 numbered one, one number up. This ensures better ventilation, safety, and comfort when transporting brachycephalic breeds.*



HYGIENIC MAT/ FEEDING/DRINKING TROUGH

For international transport, the kennel must have **the absorbent hygienic mat, the drinking and feeding trough**. All these items are supplied and installed by **Carga Viva Export** at the airport of origin.

» We recommend that the diet and hydration must not be altered because of the trip.

The feeding and watering troughs are attached to the door and will be stocked while the pet is with our staff. In transit/stopover cases, refueling will be done by the airline.

It is recommended that the owner provide a certain amount of feed, to which the animal is already used to, for it to be fed.



TOYS AND ACCESSORIES

It is important for you to know that toys, treats, leads, collars, clothes, bows, beds, pillows, and other objects **ARE NOT ALLOWED ON THE ANIMAL'S BODY AND IN THE TRAVEL KENNEL**. They will be removed by customs.

INTERNATIONAL PET TRANSPORT



Carga Viva Export has been working for over 20 years in the international transport of different types of animals, and knows how to handle your pet's trip with safety and welfare! Our director and veterinarian, Dr. Sandro Cancian (CRMV-SP 16283), is certified by IATA (International Air Transport Association) and the company is a IPATA (International Pet And Animal Transportation Association) and ATA (Animal Transportation Association) member.



DOCUMENTS

The documents and sanitary protocols are different, according to the countries of origin and destination. **Carga Viva Export** is a subject matter expert and takes care of all these requirements for you. **To board your pet on the chosen date, it is important that you contact us at least 45 days in advance.** Some documents and protocols require deadlines and scheduling for its execution, such as the International Health Certificate, issued by the country of origin's Ministry of Agriculture.



AIRLINE

Carga Viva Export carries out the study and planning of the best flights, both domestic and international, as well as the choice of the Airlines seeking for quality, safety, and the shortest traveling time. The date of the pet's trip must be set in advance and together with our team. Thus, we can get better rates and fees.



PET TAXI

Carga Viva Export has exclusive vehicles for pets transport, with thermoacoustic lining, air conditioning and anti-stress diffuser, which provides a safer and more protected place for the animal. The animal picked up by our van arrives at the airport with a calm and quiet behavior, differently from when it arrives with its owner.



Parting causes excitement and stress for the animal. To minimize this stress we do an all-stages transportation plan, ensuring safety and welfare to your pet.



PET HOTEL

When the animal is in distant cities and uses the domestic flight, it needs to arrive at least one day before the city of the international flight airport. Our veterinary team advises that the animal should rest for the next stage of the trip.

If necessary, we partner with establishments that offer the entire infrastructure to accommodate your pet with comfort, hygiene, and veterinary medical care. We make this service available in the cities of origin and destination.



CUSTOMS CLEARANCE

During customs clearance, customs procedures are carried out with physical and documentary animal's inspections by the Ministry of Agriculture, the Internal Revenue Service and the Airline. **Carga Viva Export** performs customs clearance both at origin and at the destination.

The inspections are performed by our customs brokers who are specialized in animal clearance. It is a technical, detailed, and bureaucratic process that requires the experience and knowledge of our team so that the pet's boarding does not run the risk of being canceled.

The complexity of clearance at the destination airport varies according to the country. For your peace of mind and convenience, we suggest hiring this service, and we also offer the pet cab to the final destination (door to door). Both services are optional, ask for a quotation.



GETTING TO KNOW THE AIRPLANE

The cargo compartment of the airplane, unlike what most people think, is a safe place, with pressure, ventilation, lighting, and temperature control. The wall is anti-noise and the travel kennel is attached to the aircraft's floor through straps, so it does not move during the flight.



Animals are always the last to be boarded on the aircraft and the first to be removed. In countries with extreme temperatures, an air-conditioned airline vehicle transports the animal to the cargo terminal, during boarding or landing.



VETERINARY AND TECHNICAL TEAM

Our team of veterinarians and technicians will guide you through the trip's step-by-step during boarding and landing, and also on the documents and exams required for the international transport of your pet. By hiring **Carga Viva Export** you can make a video conference with one of our veterinarians to ask questions.

We also have partnerships, in Brazil and abroad, with veterinary clinics able to perform vaccinations, anti-parasitic treatments, microchipping, rabies serology, and a health certificate for the animal.



SEDATION

The use of sedatives and tranquilizers is not permitted by the airlines. They interfere with the animal's vital senses and natural balance, which can lead to falls and trauma.



MEDICATION

For the animal that needs continuous medication, **Carga Viva Export** has a team of veterinarians that can maintain the treatment during boarding and landing. Tell our team about your pet's needs.
